



MEMORANDUM

on cooperation

« 25 » March 2026 y.

Institute for retraining and advanced training of pedagogical and specialized personnel in the field of veterinary medicine and livestock (Uzbekistan, Samarkand) represented by Director Davlatov Ravshan Berdievich acting on the basis of the charter, and educational institution **Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University (Kyrgyz Republic, Bishkek)** represented by Rector Alpaslan Ceylan, acting on the basis of the Charter, jointly referred to as the 'Parties' and individually as the 'Party', have entered into this Agreement as follows:

1. SUBJECT OF AGREEMENT

1.1. By signing this agreement, the Parties confirm that the interests of each of them correspond to joint and coordinated cooperation in the field of professional development of pedagogical and managerial staff of educational organizations of higher education.

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

2.1. In order to ensure co-operation, which is the subject of this Agreement, the Parties agree, subject to the necessary conditions, to assist each other in the following areas:

-assistance in organizing and conducting events aimed at improving the qualifications of teaching staff of higher and professional education institutions, employees of research institutions and specialists;

-assistance in organizing and conducting events aimed at improving the qualifications of teaching staff of higher and professional education institutions, employees of research institutions and specialists;

-promoting the development of educational programs and resources in the field of professional development for faculty members of higher and vocational education institutions, employees of research institutions and specialists;

-development of methodological materials for joint programs in the field of professional development of teaching staff of higher and vocational education institutions, employees of research institutions and specialists;

-Exchange of information, education, training and methodological materials, including for use and publication by Parties in open sources;

-implementation of joint educational and scientific projects, holding international scientific and practical events (forums, symposia, conferences, seminars, webinars, etc.);

-Assistance in training of scientific-pedagogical staff of higher qualification;
-professional development, working visits, internships of teaching staff and researchers;

-assistance in publishing scientific works of the staff in their scientific collections;

-organization and carrying out of cultural, mass, sports and recreational activities;

-holding of consultations, joint working meetings, round tables and other events in order to develop proposals for the implementation of the program of the Centre's activities;

-the Parties shall carry out joint actions in accordance with the procedure and on the terms and conditions of this Agreement, separate agreements concluded between the Parties, as well as implement joint activities in accordance with the roadmap approved by the Parties.

2.2. In the process of realisation of the set goal, the Parties undertake to build their relations on the basis of equality, honest and fair partnership, as well as protection of each other's interests.

2.3. To implement cooperation, the Parties shall use their available resources, may use the resources of third parties, assuming responsibility to the other Parties for their actions, and shall inform each other in writing about the use of resources.

2.4. The conditions required for the funding of each program and activity shall be mutually negotiated and agreed by both parties in writing prior to the commencement of a particular program or activity.

2.5. This Agreement does not grant either Party the right to enter into agreements (contracts) with third parties on behalf of the other Party.

3. RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

3.1. The Parties within the framework of this Agreement have the right to:

3.1.1. Send requests and proposals in the part of activities described in the Agreement;

3.1.2. Initiate consultations, joint working meetings, round tables and other events;

3.1.3. Take part in educational activities of the Parties;

3.1.4. Provide mutual information support;

3.1.5. If necessary, to invite representatives of the Parties to work in councils, commissions, working groups of the Parties, to participate in seminars, meetings, other events held by the Parties, to develop regulatory documents, methodological recommendations on the issues that are the subject of this Agreement;

3.1.6. Provide mutual advisory and organizational assistance in the areas of cooperation provided for by this Agreement;

3.1.7. Make proposals on the development of cooperation between the Parties.

4. OTHER TERMS OF THE AGREEMENT

4.1. The Parties shall be released from liability for partial or full non-fulfilment of obligations under this Agreement if it was caused by force majeure circumstances.

4.2. The party referring to force majeure shall inform the other party within three days by written notice and confirm the force majeure with a certificate of the relevant official body.

5. FINAL PROVISIONS

5.1. Amendments to this Agreement shall be made by mutual consent of the Parties and shall be executed in the form of additional agreements, which after signing by the Parties shall be an integral part of this Agreement.

5.2. This Agreement shall not impose any financial obligations on the signatory Parties.

5.3. This Agreement shall come into force from the date of its signing, shall be valid for 5 (five) years and shall be deemed prolonged for subsequent five-year periods, unless either Party notifies the other Party in writing of its intention to terminate it no later than 3 (three) months prior to the expiry of the relevant period.

5.4. This Agreement may be terminated on the initiative of any Party by written notice to the other Party not less than 6 (six) months from the date of such notice.





5.5. This Agreement is drawn up and signed in two copies having equal legal force, one for each of the Parties.

5.6. This Agreement is not confidential. Upon signing of this Agreement, the Parties may issue an appropriate press release.

5.7. The Parties have agreed to issue joint press releases in the future, in connection with significant events related to the execution of this Agreement.

5.8. All disputes, disagreements or claims arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled by the Parties through negotiations.
