



Memorandum of Understanding

Kazakh Scientific Research Veterinary Institute (KazSRVI) Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University (“KTMU”)

KazSRVI is a research organization operating under the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and engaged in scientific research in the field of veterinary science, diagnostics, and biological safety.

Kyrgyz-Turkish Manas University is a public institute of higher education, founded on a charter signed by the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Government of the Republic of Turkey.

Each a “Party” and together the “Parties”.

By execution of this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the “Memorandum” or “MOU”), the Parties hereby agree as follows:


1. This MOU is made and entered into as of the date of the last signature on the signature page (the “Effective Date”) by and between the KazSRVI and the KTMU.
2. The Parties express their mutual interest in developing cooperation, with a primary focus on scientific research activities, aimed at strengthening scientific and technical capacity, advancing modern diagnostic methods and biological safety, as well as expanding collaboration in professional capacity building, and consider it mutually beneficial to explore the implementation of the following activities (the “Activities”):
 - (1) exchange of scientific and technical literature, methodological materials, and research results;
 - (2) collaboration in scientific research and technological development, including the implementation of joint projects and preparation of scientific publications;
 - (3) exchange of researchers and specialists for the purposes of training, advanced studies, and research activities;
 - (4) organization of joint workshops, symposia, and other scientific and technical events on topics of mutual interest;
 - (5) exchange of scientific information, expertise, and best practices, including approaches to standardization, validation, and implementation of modern diagnostic and research methods;
 - (6) development of cooperation in the field of laboratory quality assurance, inter-laboratory (proficiency) testing, and the development and use of reference materials and panels, as well as methodological support of laboratory activities.
3. By executing this MOU, neither Party commits to initiating any of the Activities listed above. Should the Parties agree to undertake any specific Activity, the details of such Activity, including conditions for the use of results, arrangements for visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation, shall be negotiated on a case-by-case basis and formalized in a separate written agreement executed by both Parties. In the event of any conflict between the terms of such separate agreement and this MOU, the terms of the separate agreement shall prevail. For the avoidance of doubt, neither Party shall bear any obligations with respect to any Activity under this MOU.
4. As part of the planned development of the above Activities, KazSRVI designates KTMU as a Research and Academic Coordinator. As specific Activities are selected for implementation, the designated coordinators of the Parties shall collaborate with the relevant units to determine when separate written agreements are required, and to ensure alignment of scientific approaches, effective exchange of results, and coordination of joint research activities. In turn, KTMU designates KazSRVI as a Research and Academic Coordinator.
5. Any financial arrangements to be made between the parties will need to be agreed to, in writing, in a separate agreement.

6. This MOU shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from the Effective Date. This MOU may be terminated by either Party upon thirty (30) days' written notice signed by an authorized representative of the notifying Party and delivered to the other Party. Any Activity agreed upon by the Parties prior to the date of termination shall not be affected by such termination, unless otherwise agreed by the Parties. This MOU may be renewed for additional five (5)-year periods upon mutual written agreement of the Parties, provided that such agreement is made at least six (6) months prior to its expiration.
7. This MOU is a non-binding agreement and reflects the mutual understanding of the Parties regarding potential cooperation. It does not create any legally binding obligations between the Parties. This MOU may be amended or modified only by a written agreement duly executed by authorized representatives of both Parties.
